

Ordinance 697

An ordinance amending Ordinance 679, Section 3, regulating outside burning within the Borough of Blairsville.

Be it ordained and hereby enacted by the Borough of Blairsville as follows:

Burning, in compliance with this ordinance, shall be permitted only on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays, from December to September. In the months of October and November, burning is permitted on Tuesday and Saturday each week. Hours of acceptable burning are between the hours of 8am and 8pm. Under no conditions shall waste burning, as defined herein, be permitted any other time. Fires allowed to burn or smolder after 8pm shall be in violation of this ordinance, and all those persons or corporations causing such fires shall be prosecuted under the guidelines of this ordinance.

Recreational burning is specifically excluded from this ordinance; provided however, that said recreational burning is done in accordance with the definition set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

All other sections of Ordinance 679 shall remain in full force and effect.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed as of the date of this ordinance.
