

Ordinance # 686

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BLAIRSVILLE REGULATING THE TIME THAT TRASH AND REFUSE CONTAINERS MAY BE PLACED ALONG A SIDEWALK, CURB, STREET, ALLEY, OR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE REQUIREMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Blairsville as is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

Section 1 - Ordinance is hereby enacted in its entirety to provide as follows:

“No trash may be placed on the sidewalk, curb, or along a public street or alley right-of-way for collection earlier than 12:00 Noon on the day before collection day. Trash and refuse containers must be removed from the sidewalk, curb, or along any public street or alley right-of-way no later than 12:00 Noon on the day after collection. Violation of this section shall constitute a summary criminal offense and upon conviction may be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

Section 2 This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
